New York State Broadcasters Internship Program

This program recruits throughout the state for paid summer internships. Internships were awarded by New York State Broadcasters Association to our radio stations. We recruited through radio station ads, websites and made specific efforts to contact local high school guidance counselors, GIAC (Greater Ithaca Activity Center), Southside Community Center plus local college internship supervisors. The interns had to be between the ages of 17 and 21, reside in New York State or go to school in New York .

Cayuga Radio Group has an ongoing relationship with Ithaca College, Cornell College, Tompkins Cortland Community College, Cortland State College, and our local high schools. We provide unpaid or unpaid for credit internships throughout the school year and summer. The internships give students the opportunity to work in all of our departments and then specialize in their field of interest.

Cayuga Radio Group has an ongoing shadowing and mentoring program with students in the community who have an interest in broadcasting.

Our employees are guest lecturers in classes at Cornell University, Tompkins Cortland Community College, and Ithaca College. They also serve as guest speakers at area high schools for “career day”.

We look at all of these as opportunities for outreach and recruitment.

Throughout 2009, General Manager Susan Johnston participated, as a business leader and a chamber member, in a series of meetings discussing issues of race, class, and employment. The program is called “A Community Conversation on Racism and Equity” sponsored by the Tompkins County Chamber of Commerce.

In September 2008, Cayuga Radio Group created and maintained a segment on WHCU, which runs Tuesdays from 8:30am to 9am, called All Things Equal. This program addresses racism, ethnicity, recruitment, and sustainability issues. This program continues as a permanent segment on WHCU.
